#### 5. President's Report

**B20/103** Ken reviewed his report to the Board.

Covid 19 campus updates:

Vancouver – all but a few staff members are working remotely & all classes are now online. Merritt – Merritt employees are transitioning to a partial work from home and the majority of the classes are now online. The Learning Commons will remain open for students.

The transition to moving online was fairly seamless with few student issues and everyone was advised of the possibility of moving online. Appreciation was expressed to the Leadership Team for all of their work during these trying times.

The Prior Learning Assessment [PLAR] framework and Academic Appeals policy are under revision and a 10 Year Stale Date Policy will be developed.

Elaine reported that NVIT will have to go through a quality assurance process audit in the future. All programs must have program reviews and updated course outlines & policies.

#### 8. Audit & Risk Management Committee

the Q2 Financial & FTE Reports (MD&A) be approved. *Motion Carried*.

As of November, NVIT achieved 70.3% of the FTE target & it is anticipated to substantially achieve the FTE target by the end of the fiscal year. Finance is projecting a small surplus at the end of the fiscal year, due in part, because NVIT does not depend on funding from International students.

### 9. Indigenous Language Programs

#### 10. NVIT's Security Card - BCNET

NVIT gets 1 or 2 attempts daily & on Nov 14<sup>th</sup> had 44 attempts but the firewall protected us. It is anticipated that fraud and scam training will be provided to all staff in the future.
