

“Westbank First Nation has been working in partnership with NVIT to deliver these assessments with great success for the last year. The community based assessment is delivered to our Active Measures participants who are engaged in a 14 week Life Skills program.

The Community Based assessment is delivered by NVIT in the first week of the program. The results of these assessments provide us with the opportunity of designing an upgrading program to suit the participant's needs. While attending the 14 week program, the participants have an opportunity of completing a core component of upgrading in our own community without the need to travel outside the reserve and to ensure the completion of the component within a semester period.

As a result of this project, we have been successful in having 5 students complete the Language Proficiency Index exam (grade 12 English) and 2 participants have completed their grade 10 Trades 10 Math.

Westbank First Nations whole heartily supports this initiative and will continue to utilize the service. Our support is heartfelt and we wish to express our sincere desire for this ongoing service.”
