

Technical Safety BC Entrance Bursary 2024

Purpose:

Technical Safety BC is an independent, self-funded organization that oversees the safe installation and operation of technical systems and equipment across the province. In addition to issuing permits, licences and certificates, they work with industry to reduce safety risks through assessment, education and outreach, enforcement, and research.

Amount:

Three (3) bursaries of \$4000 each, will be provided by Technical Safety BC to support learners in their studies, particularly in technical/trades education and/or social sciences.

Eligibility Criteria:

This bursary is open to all students of Indigenous ancestry who are enrolled full-time (60% or higher) in any program, at any campus for the 24/25 academic year. Applicants must meet the below criteria to be considered.

Checklist:

- Be of Indigenous ancestry
- Proof of enrolment in a full-time course load in any program (60% or higher) for the 24/25 academic year at any NVIT Campus via an unofficial NVIT Transcript or registration statement
- Budget Information

Deadline:

The NVIT Registration Office must receive applications by 4:30pm on August 15, 2024. If August 15th lands on a weekend, the application will be due the last business day before the deadline. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. Please email, mail or drop off original copies.
