



NVIT ELDERS' COUNCIL BURSARY 2018-2019

Purpose:

The NVIT Elders' Council Bursary is meant to recognize and support full-time students who strive to complete their studies and maintain a balance with their finances and other outside priorities.

Eligibility:

The NVIT Elders' Council Bursary is awarded to two (2) full-time students in any program; one from the Merritt campus and one from the Vancouver campus, based on demonstrated financial need, academic achievement and performed community service. The recipients must meet their respective program's minimum grade point averages. The recipients will also be required to attend the first Elders' Council meeting the following October and/or November to introduce themselves to the NVIT Elders' Council.

Value:

The NVIT Elders' Council will disburse two (02) bursaries valued at \$250.00 each per academic year.

Process:

Students will complete the attached application form, transcript and submit a 500-word essay (maximum) on the following:

1. who you are;
2. why you are going to school;
3. what program you would like to graduate from (what you would like to become after graduation [career]);
4. demonstrated financial need; and
5. performed community service.

Please include a title page named, "NVIT Elders' Council Bursary"; include the date and year of the essay submission, including your full name.

Deadline:

The deadline to submit your essay is April 30, 2019 by 4:30pm. Students may appeal the decision by submitting a written letter to the award adjudication committee attention:
