

# Pat Brownlee-Baker Memorial Scholarship

## **Purpose:**

Pat Brownlee-Baker was an instructor at NVIT involved with the adult basic education program at various female correctional institutes. She aspired to see women transition successfully back into society. In 2010, she passed away after a long and valiant fight with cancer. Deeply loved and fondly remembered by her family, this award is sponsored by John Brownlee-Baker, her husband, in her memory.

## **Eligibility:**

The Pat Brownlee-Baker Memorial Scholarship is awarded to two (2) Aboriginal female students, enrolled in any program, any level of studies, full or part-time studies from either campus, who were previously released from incarceration and demonstrate financial need. If no students apply, the award will be opened to all Aboriginal female students.

## **Criteria:**

Students must submit a completed application with two (2) instructor character reference letters attesting to the student's skills and abilities to be eligible for the scholarship.

## **Amount:**

Each year, two (2) awards of \$500 each will be presented to recipients at the annual NVIT awards ceremony.

## **Deadline:**

The deadline to submit the application and reference letters to the Registrar's Office is April 30, 2019 by 4:30pm.
