Chair Elaine brought up the management of hybrid course delivery in the Fall and what that means to students and faculty in terms of support, access to IT and requirements, and course delivery.

Verna responded that the Ministry has mandated a COVID response plan and a return to work plan that needs to be in place by July 31<sup>st</sup>. Given the unpredictability of the pandemic, NVIT's response is based on current protocols and direction from the provincial health officer and WorkSafe BC.

Kylie noted that NVIT is one of a few schools that is offering hybrid delivery and NVIT's planning is designed to respond to the ever-changing environment.

Appreciation was given to the students who participated on EdCo this year.
