Eligibility:

The Micheal and Cecilia Street Memorial Bursary is awarded to one (1) full-time, Indigenous student (non-status/self-identifying included) from the Merritt or Vancouver campus, who is enrolled in a minimum 80% course load in any field of study (Developmental Education, Employment Skills Access, Youth Explore Trades, and Bridging to Trades are excluded). The recipients must demonstrate financial need and dedication to their studies, display citizenship qualities, and describe their balance between home (including hobbies), work and educational lifestyles. The student must have attained a minimum 3.0 (B) grade point average in their current year of studies.

Criteria:
