

Nicola Naturalist Society Entrance Scholarship 2025 Application

Purpose:

The Nicola Naturalist Society was formed in 2010, based in Merritt, BC. Membership is open to anyone interested in nature, wildlife and the health of local ecosystems. Along with more than 50 other naturalist clubs in British Columbia, they are a member of BC Nature (Federation of BC Naturalists).

A major objective of the Nicola Naturalist Society is to provide education and information on the wild organisms and ecosystems of the BC interior, especially those, found in the Nicola Valley and surrounding areas.

Eligibility:

The award recognizes a full-time, graduating first year Environmental Resources Technology (ENRT) student from NVIT at the Merritt campus expecting to continue into his/her second year of studies of ENRT at NVIT.

The applicant must demonstrate high academic achievement, motivation, self-discipline, and dedication to his/her studies, and plan on pursuing a career in the Environmental and/or Natural Resources Field. The applicant must also be a Canadian citizen.

Value:

The Nicola Naturalist Society will donate one (1) award of \$1000 to be distributed at the annual NVIT awards ceremony. The recipient will be expected to attend the first evening meeting of the Nicola Naturalist Society after that date.

Process:

Students must complete the following application process.

Complete and sign the application form.
Submit, in a sealed envelope, the recommendation form completed and signed by an NVIT
Environmental Resources Technology Faculty Member.
Write a 300-500 word, typed essay answering the following questions, "What have you learned in the
program that will apply to your future?" and "How will your learning help you in future field work?"; and
An NVIT transcript.

Deadline:

The NVIT Registration Office must receive applications by 4:30pm on August 15, 2025. If August 15th lands on a weekend, the application will be due the last business day <u>before</u> the deadline. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. Please email to <u>awards@nvit.ca</u> or drop off original copies at the registration front desk.
