Purpose:

Eligibility:

Awarded to a full-time Indigenous student studying on the Vancouver campus who identifies they are from either the Hul'qumi'num, Kwikwetlem, Katzie, Kwantlen, Malahat, ʂxʷməθkʷəy̓əmaʔɫ təməxʷ (Musqueam), Skwxwú7mesh-uth Semiahmoo, Temíxw (Squamish), səliwətaʔɫ təməxʷ (Tsleil-Waututh), Tsawwassen, Snuneymuxw, Ləkʷəŋən, or Stó:lō territories. Students must also speak to their connection to their community. If no applicant from any of the listed areas applies, then applicants from the next closest band/nation geographically will be considered.

Value:

Two (2) \$2,500.00 awards will be presented at the annual NVIT graduation ceremony. If the student is not graduating this year, the student will be emailed with notice to contact awards@nvit.ca to redeem their award.

Checklist:

Students must complete the following application checklist:

- Complete and sign the application form.
- Proof of verification of ancestry either by submitting a status card or letter, written by one of the listed communities on Band/Tribal letterhead.
- Complete a 300-500 word essay on their connection to their community.

Deadline:

The NVIT Registration Office must receive applications by 4:30pm on March 31, 2026. If March 31st lands on a weekend, the application will be due the last business day before the deadline. Please email a copy to awards@nvit.ca or drop off the original copy at the front desk of either campus; faxes and/or photocopies will not be accepted. Reference letters must also be submitted through email to awards@nvit.ca.
